## Dancer Participation Agreement - Pre-Ballet 4 & 5 Level Students

Pre-Ballet students will perform in ONE of the three performances.

In order to maintain the professionalism of this huge production, all participants must be a current Long Beach Ballet Academy student through June 30, 2017 and agree to the following Parent/Student requirements:

- *Students must remain current in their class attendance and tuition through the month of June. June tuition is due no later than June 2, 2017*
- *Return this signed agreement together with the \$150.00 participation fee\* on or before Wednesday, March 1, 2017.*
- *Costume materials are included the performance fee. Student's family is responsible for costume assembly (self-sewn or pay LBBA seamstress)*
- *Attend all studio rehearsals (in addition to student's regular ballet class) beginning Saturday, April 1<sup>st</sup> and adhere to the attendance and tardy policies (see below)\*\**
- *Attend all scheduled theater stage rehearsals for dancer's role scheduled during production week: May 31 – June 2, 2017 (afternoon/early evening time tbd)*

We look forward to another successful Spring Performance! With everyone's commitment to their role in this production, we know that this will be another amazing production!

### \*Participation Fee

*The participation fee covers the additional rehearsals and costume materials, as well as help offset expenses for presenting this production at the Carpenter Center. It is vital for LBBA to confirm the number of participants by the first day of rehearsal in order for us to proceed with choreography and costumes.*

*\*\* Attendance/Tardy Policy – Whatever the reason, if a student misses a rehearsal or is too late to join the rehearsal, that rehearsal becomes less productive for everyone. Please make sure that your child arrives a few minutes before the beginning of his/her scheduled rehearsal and is ready to begin rehearsal at the designated time. A student will be considered "absent" if he/she arrives 10 minutes or later after the beginning of the scheduled rehearsal. A 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> absence will receive a written warning to the parent/student. A 3<sup>rd</sup> absence will be a mandatory \$50.00 donation to the school. A 4<sup>th</sup> and final absence will result in being dropped from the cast. All scheduled theater stage rehearsals must be attended. A missed theater stage rehearsal will result in either being dropped from the production or assessed a \$200.00 fine at the discretion of the Director. Fines must be paid prior to the student's next rehearsal.*

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*I have read the above information and agree to the requirements for my child to participate in this year's production of Long Beach Ballet's "Aladdin."*

*I understand that the Participation Fee is non-refundable.*
