Participation in individual performances will depend on student’s assigned role and cast.

Student Participation Agreement

In order to maintain the professionalism of this huge production, all participants must agree to the following Parent/Student requirements:

- Students must be a current LBB student for the full month of September 2017 and remain current in their class attendance and class tuition through the month of December 2017. Tuition in full for the month of December is due no later than Dec. 9th.
- Return this signed agreement and pay the non-refundable \$215.00 participation fee no later than Sept 27th by 12:00 noon
- Children Level 3 through Academy Level dancers attend the role audition on Sunday, October 1st.
- Attend all scheduled Saturday rehearsals for student’s role beginning Sat., October 7th (or first day of role’s rehearsal)
- Understand that rehearsals are *in addition* to student’s regular ballet classes.
- Attend the in-studio final run-through rehearsal on Sunday, December 10th.
- Adhere to the rehearsal attendance and lateness policy (see below)*
- Sign up for a parent volunteer assignment
- Attend all scheduled theater stage rehearsals for assigned role/cast. Theater rehearsals are mandatory**

We look forward to another successful Nutcracker season! With everyone’s commitment to their role in this production, we know that this will be the best year yet!

* Attendance/Lateness Policy – Whatever the reason, if a student misses a rehearsal or is late, that rehearsal becomes less productive for everyone. An absence for any reason is considered a “missed rehearsal.” Please make sure that your child arrives a few minutes before the beginning of his/her scheduled rehearsal and be ready to begin rehearsal at the designated times. A student will be considered “absent” if he/she arrives 15 minutes or later than the beginning of the scheduled rehearsal. A 1st offense will receive a written warning to the parent/student. A 2nd offense will be a mandatory \$25.00 donation to the school. A 3rd offense will be a mandatory \$50.00 donation to the school. A 4th and final offense will result in being dropped from the cast. **All scheduled theater stage rehearsals must be attended. A missed theater stage rehearsal or performance will result in either being dropped from the production or assessed a \$200.00 fine at the discretion of the Director, whether or not previous absences have been accumulated.
