Upon registration, Student must be available to participate in any of the six performances. Some roles may have multiple casts and participation in individual performances will depend on student's assigned role and cast.

In order to maintain the professionalism of this huge production, all participants must agree to the following Parent/Student requirements:

Student must be a current LBB student for the full month of September 2022 and remain current in their class attendance and class tuition through the month of December 2022. **The studio is closed for Winter Break and production weeks: December 13, 2022 – January 3, 2023.** Nutcracker participants are required to pay the full month tuition for December (which includes all additional theater rehearsals/performances). **Tuition in full for the month of December** is due no later than Dec. 7th.

- Return this signed agreement with the non-refundable participation fee no later than September 21st midnight.
- To confirm Student's spot in this year's cast, the participation fee is due now with this completed form.
- Registered Students (<u>Children 3 & Academy levels only</u>) must attend the *Role Audition* on **September 25th** to be assigned a role. Casting will be posted on "click-it" by the end of day on September 28th.

Parent agrees that the Student will attend all scheduled rehearsals for student's role beginning:

- Saturday, October 1st (Children & Academy)
- Saturday, November 5th (Pre-Ballet)

and weekly Saturday rehearsals thereafter through December 10th. (There is no rehearsal the weekend of Thanksgiving - Nov. 26)

- Student will attend their role's costume fitting scheduled on October 15th or 16th.
- Group photos for program are on Sunday, November 13th.
- Parent agrees that the Student will attend the in-studio final run-through rehearsal on Sunday, December 11th.
- Parent and Student understand that rehearsals are in addition to student's regular ballet classes. Cast members who do not consistently attend their minimum number of required classes per week will be dropped from the cast with no refund.
- Parent will adhere to the rehearsal attendance and lateness policy (see below)\*
- Student will attend all scheduled theater stage rehearsals for assigned role/cast. Theater rehearsals are mandatory\*\*

We look forward to another successful Nutcracker season! With everyone's commitment to their role in this production, we know that this will be the best year yet!

\*Attendance/Lateness Policy – Whatever the reason, if a student misses a rehearsal or is late, that rehearsal becomes less productive for everyone. Please make sure that your child arrives a few minutes before the beginning of his/her scheduled rehearsal and is ready to begin rehearsal at the designated times. A student will be considered "absent" if he/she arrives 15 minutes or later than the beginning of the scheduled rehearsal.

A 1st offense will receive a written warning to the parent/student. A 2nd offense will be a mandatory \$50.00 donation to the school. A 3rd offense will be an additional mandatory \$50.00 donation to the school. A 4th and final offense will result in being dropped from the cast. All scheduled theater stage rehearsals must be attended. \*\*A missed theater stage rehearsal, whether or not the absence is a first offense, will result in either being dropped from the production or assessed a \$200.00 fine at the discretion of the Director.
