Dancer Participation Agreement – CHILDREN 1 & 2

Children Level 1 & 2 students will perform in ONE of the three performances.

In order to maintain the professionalism of this huge production, all participants must be a current Long Beach Ballet Academy student January-June 2020 and agree to the following Parent/Student requirements:

- *Students must remain current in their class attendance and tuition through the month of June. June tuition is due no later than June 2, 2020.*
- *Return this signed agreement together with the \$215.00 participation fee* on or before Saturday, January 25th at 12:00 noon. Once form & fee are turned in, parent will choose a performance cast.*
- *Attend all studio rehearsals (in addition to student's regular ballet class) beginning Saturday, March 7th and adhere to the attendance and tardy policies (see below)***
- *Attend the studio run-through rehearsal on Sunday, May 31st.*
- *Attend all scheduled theater stage rehearsals for the dancer's role during the week of June 3 – June 5, 2020. Theater rehearsals are mandatory to be eligible to participate in the performances.*

With everyone's commitment to their role, we look forward to another amazing Spring production!

****Participation Fee***

The participation fee covers the additional rehearsals and costume maintenance, as well as help offset expenses for presenting this production at the Carpenter Center with a full orchestra. It is vital for LBBA to confirm the number of participants by January 25th in order for us to proceed with choreography and costumes.

*** Attendance/Tardy Policy – Whatever the reason, if a student misses a rehearsal or is too late to join the rehearsal, that rehearsal becomes less productive for everyone. Please make sure that your child arrives a few minutes before the beginning of his/her scheduled rehearsal and is ready to begin rehearsal at the designated time. A student will be considered "absent" if he/she arrives 10 minutes or later after the beginning of the scheduled rehearsal. A 1st and 2nd absence will receive a written warning to the parent/student. A 3rd absence will be a mandatory \$50.00 donation to the school. A 4th and final absence will result in being dropped from the cast. All scheduled theater stage rehearsals must be attended. A missed theater stage rehearsal will result in either being dropped from the production or assessed a \$200.00 fine at the discretion of the Director. Fines must be paid prior to the student's next rehearsal.*
