Participation Agreement & Fee

Each participating cast member must have a signed Participation Form on file and the non-refundable participation fee paid. This cost covers costumes, rehearsals, administration fees and production expenses.

<u>Important Note: All students must be current in tuition (including the month of June) and continue to attend their regular classes.</u>

Rehearsal Polices

It is important that all participants in our performances agree to adhere to the strict attendance policies for rehearsals. See your copy of the Participation Agreement for attendance policy details.

Rehearsal Dress Code for studio rehearsals: Regular class attire.

Food and Drinks: Please leave all food and drinks in the lobby of the studio. Do not leave trash on the floor or in the dressing rooms.

<u>At the theater</u>, there is a STRICT no food/drinks (water is okay) backstage policy. Please do not pack food in your dancer's bag – if you send simple, dry snacks, pack separately. Snacks may be eaten in designated areas only.

Check the Bulletin Board and your emails for updates. It is your responsibility to keep informed of any changes to the schedule.

At the Theater: Rehearsals at the theater usually run fairly smoothly, but at times we get behind. We ask that parents be patient; your child will be returned to you as quickly as possible. We only keep them as long as it takes to make sure that we will have a fabulous performance! Please note that your child <u>must</u> be picked up within 15 minutes of release.

Make-up: Light blush, light brown eye shadow, eyeliner, red lipstick

Children 1/2 (Jesters): Hair pulled back into a HIGH ballet bun, no bangs

Make-up: Light blush, light brown eye shadow, eyeliner, red lipstick

Children 3 (Russian Dance): Hair parted in the middle pulled back into a LOW ballet bun, no bangs

Make-up: Light blush, light brown eye shadow, eyeliner, pink lipstick

Academy 1 (Spanish Dance) Hair parted in the middle pulled back into a LOW ballet bun, no bangs Make-up: Light blush, light brown eye shadow, eyeliner, pink lipstick

Academy 2 (Neapolitan Dance) Hair braided and criss-crossed over the top of head

Make-up: Light blush, light brown eye shadow, eyeliner, pink lipstick

Academy 3 (Mazurka Dance) Hair pulled back into a bun in the middle of the head, no bangs Make-up: Light blush, light brown eye shadow, eyeliner, pink lipstick

Academy 4 (Czardas): Hair parted in the middle pulled back into a LOW ballet bun, no bangs

Performance Notes For Theater Rehearsal and Performances

<u>Food:</u> There is a STRICT no food/drinks (water is okay) backstage policy. Please do not pack food in your dancer's bag – if you send simple, dry snacks, pack separately. Snacks maybe eaten in designate areas only. Please keep dressing rooms as neat as possible. We are assessed a high janitorial fee if dressing rooms are not clean and charged \$100 each time food or evidence of food (wrappers) is found in dressing rooms. If a student is found with food in a dressing room, the student and parent will be charged the fine.

<u>Attire</u>: Regular ballet attire for theater rehearsals on June 3-5. All cast members will be responsible for providing their own tights (if colored tights are not provided as part of their role's costume) and shoes for the performance.

<u>Make-up</u>: For DRESS REHEARSAL on Friday, June 5, Students' make-up should be done before they arrive. Chaperones will be able to touch-up before the performance. Specific make-up and hair instructions will be provided prior to the final studio run through.

<u>Backstage Chaperones</u>: Only official chaperones are allowed backstage and in the theater rehearsals. All students are fully chaperoned once they are signed in at the theater.

Recording Devices: Note that still and video cameras are strictly prohibited at the theater

Theater Drop-off & Pick-up procedures:

Every cast member must have a parent/guardian who will sign them in and out. Parents who are not official chaperones will not be allowed in theater during rehearsals, backstage or in dressing room areas at any time.

Map and Sign-in/Drop-off procedure will be provided as we get closer to theater week.

Parent Volunteers

We need your help!

There are many interesting jobs "behind the scenes" of a ballet performance. Without volunteer support, this production would not be possible!

The following "teams" of volunteers are organized to provide the utmost efficiency; keep in mind we are organizing a performance with over 250 cast members!

Volunteer sign-ups begin on Saturday, May 2nd and will be posted along the studio hallway. At that time, you can sign up for specific times and duties. Sign-ups are first come, first served.

Costumes (Cheryl Cartwright, Team Leader):

Help with costumes backstage during rehearsals and performances (mending, quick changes, pack up for transport, etc.)

Scenery Transport Team

Transporting scenery from the warehouse to the theater. Set-up & strike (tear-down after the performance). Several able-bodied men are needed in this category.

Backstage Crew

This group must be at the theater ½ hour before cast calls for the rehearsals and performances. Please only apply for this position if you can be consistent and attend all stage rehearsals and performances. The complexity of this production will require knowledge of the show.

Good Luck-Grams:

Help with sales at the studio. Arrive 1½ hours before performance time. Help organize, sell and deliver to dancers backstage.

Backstage Cast Management (Jennifer Oliver, Team Leader):

Each level should have at least 2-3 chaperones per rehearsal and performance. This group oversees supervision for their level while waiting to perform and getting dancers ready (costumes, make-up and hair). This group should arrive to the theater rehearsals/performances ½ hour before cast calls.
